I understand that I or any party affected by the Minute Order may file a written Request for a Full Decision within 15 calendar days from the day of mailing of the Minute Order, on a form provided by the Rent Board. If the Request for a Full Decision is received at the Rent Board within the prescribed time period, the Minute Order will be dissolved automatically and a full Decision will issue within 45 days after the day of receipt of the request at the Rent Board. The full decision may be appealed within 15 days after it is mailed. It is my understanding that I MUST request a full decision within 15 calendar days of the issuance of a Minute Order in order to preserve my right to appeal. I further understand that if the Request for a Full Decision is not filed within the prescribed time period, the
